

IN 1992 DURING A SURVEY IN THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 7 PUTNAM TWP., I FOUND WHAT I BELIEVED TO BE M BULLOCKS TWO WITNESS TREES AND THE MEASURES INTERSECTED ON THE WEST BANK OF THE ANDERSON COUNTY DRAIN 28.00 FEET SOUTH OF THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 7 PUTNAM TWP. WHICH WAS A SET 1/2" I. ROD IN AN OLD FENCE CORNER POST HOLE RUNG WITH STONE AND FENCES TO THE NORTH, EAST AND SOUTH. GLO JOG WAS 17.82 FEET NORTH TO THE PUTNAM CORNER. WE DID NOT FIND ANY FENCE RUNNING TO THE WEST FROM THE POINT OF INTERSECTION OF THE TWO WITNESSES BY M BULLOCK. THIS YEAR WE FOUND THE CORNER I HAD SET FOR PUTNAM TWP.
