PIPE WE FOUND MATCHED ATWELL-HICKS WITNESSES FROM A 1986 SURVEY. AND THIS PIPE WAS LOCATED 3.75 FT. EAST AND 7.02 FT. SOUTH FROM THE WITNESSES R JAGOW HAD ON HIS 1978 ACT 74, JAGOW'S 1978 I. PIPE WAS GONE. IT APPEARS THAT IN A LATER SURVEY BY ATWELL-HICKS THEY SET M-7 TO THE NORTH AT A POINT OTHER THAN R JAGOW'S RECORDED M-7 AND THEN SET A NEW M-8 ON LINE WITH M-9 TO THE SOUTH (WHERE R JAGOW HAD M-9) AND M-7 TO THE NORTH WHERE THEY HAD RELOCATED R JAGOWS M-7 AND AT HALF DISTANCE, THIS BEING THE IRON PIPE WE FOUND.
