WE FOUND A 3/4" I. PIPE WITH CAP NO. 6998 (R JAGOW SR.) FLUSH WITH THE GROUND ABOUT 12 FT. SOUTHERLY OF A 2 TRACK TRAIL ON U OF M LANDS AND ABOUT 10 FT. ABOVE SAID SWAMP. ATWELL-HICKS MEASURED SOUTH 2677.64 FT AND WE HAD 2677.96 FT. ATWELL-HICKS MEASURED NORTH 2645.67 FT. AND WE HAD 2645.84 FT. SITE IS NOT GOOD FOR GPS.
