

## M-11 NORTHEAST CORNER SEC. 36, T1N, R3E, UNADILLA TWP.

CORNER NOT FOUND. ORIGINALLY SET IN LAKE. I FOUND STRONG INDICATION WITH METAL DETECTOR IN 3 FT. DEEP WATER 33' SOUTH OF PATERSON LAKE SHORE LINE. FOUND 1-1/2" IRON PIPE REFERENCE POINT 12.5 FEET NORTH OF WATERS EDGE. THIS PIPE WAS SET OR FOUND BY CLAY GORDON IN THE 1929 SURVEY OF "THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN FRESH AIR CAMP". I WILL LEAVE CORNER UNSET PLACE TWO LIVINGSTON COUNTY REMONUMENTATION REFERENCE MONUMENTS ON EAST LINE OF SECTION 25; ONE REPLACING ABOVE (46 FEET NORTH OF M-11) THE AND ONE 191.20 FEET NORTH OF ABOVE, PER A RECONSTRUCTION OF THE GARLOCK SURVEY OF 1978. (P.16) AND BOSS SURVEY OF 1991 (P.17).

1825 Sylvester Sibley, Deputy U.S. Surveyor, measures from south, Corner to Sec. 25 & 36 in Lake. North on East Boundary of Sec. 25, chain, leave lake; 16 chains, to Lake..."

Clay Gorden survey of "Fresh Air Camp", shows "iron pipe on shore" 46 feet north of section corner in lake. (P.9) 1" iron pipe at high water line. (7' dia. Elm witness and other, now gone.) P.10.

1959 March. Lyle Munsell shows symbol for iron 46' north of Sec. corner in lake. Shows 7' Elm. P. 11. April, shows 1" iron pipe at shore; 7" Elm now stump. P.13. N/S fence built 4' west of Section line. P.14 (fence remains today)

1963 & 1978 Garlock surveys at Section line and lake shore, P.15-16.

1991 Boss surveys along East line of Section 25 and north of Garlock surveys, shows and uses "1-1/4" iron pipe, 15' north of water's edge and north of Southeast corner Section 25, referred to by Munsell and Gorden".

M-11, T1N, R3E, UNADILLA, Corner in lake (not set). Established two 1" 36" iron pipes, affixed with 2" dia. brass disk.
Disks stamped "Livingston Co. Witness Corner, 19834" and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of accessory positions to the original corner. See sketch.
