Corner first set by Joseph Wampler, 1819 "west on the south boundary Section 35, 80.00 chains, set post common to Sec. 34 and 35."

1849, John Mullett, Deputy Surveyor, in a remeasurement of lines between Fletcher Base line of 1816 and Wampler Base line of 1819, shows falling with NE cor. Sec. 3 and NW cor. Sec. 2, T1S, Dexter, Washtenaw Co. (I-1) to be 9.23 chains (609.18').

1970, Edwin McCombs, Consumers Power, set "T" iron, 555.23' West of I-1, Dexter.

1971, Gary Stonerock surveyed for Detroit Edison Co., fd. "T" iron for corner.

1977, Boss uses "T" iron and constructs straight line north to East 1/4 corner, I-12.

1978, Boss files Act 74 on corner for survey in SE 1/4 sec. 34. dated Oct. 5, 1977.
