SUMMARY

East | Corner Section 25, T1N-R5E Hamburg Township, Livingston County, Michigan.

Found $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron in concrete occupational tree row and fenced North, South and West. Area open to the East but corner will be difficult for G.P.S. due to heavily wooded corner.

Land corner recordation certificates by Marvin D. Pike in 1974 (pages 13-14) and Brad F. Thompson in 1993 agree on findings. G.L.O. calls for 873 links (576.18 feet) but actual measurements were found to be 453.98 feet from East 1 corner of Section 25 to the West 1 corner of Section 30, TIN-R6E Green Oak Township. Number 8 witness on page 7 witness sheet appears to be same as Miles Bullock witness in 1876 on page 10 of this dossier.

Conclusion: We find the 1974 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rod in concrete to be the same $\frac{1}{2}$ iron found on 2-15-95 and recommend its acceptance.
