

CORNER SUMMARY

C-13, SE Corner, Section 31 Green Oak Township, Livingston County

The oldest known witness is by G.H. Davis in 1899, recorded in the field book of old county surveyor's records. Davis references the corner as being 0.56 chains East of the NE corner of Section 6 of Northfield Township. This is the only reference that the corner and the NE corner of Section 6 are different locations. In 1939 Clay Gordon first references the corner and the NE corner of Section 6 as the same location. The corner is also witnessed by Bullock in 1906, by Pettibone prior to 1924, by Atwell in 1924, by L.A. Smith in 1935, by Clay Gordon again in 1945, by Atwell-Hicks, Inc. in 1974, by Midwestern Consulting in 1977, by T. Sutherland in 1979, by Henry Andres in 1981, by Atwell-Hicks, Inc. twice in 1984, by Boss in 1985 and twice in 1989 and by Garlock in 1992.

Atwell-Hicks, Inc. located a 3/4" iron pipe with a Washtenaw County Road Commission cap in 1994. The witness summary shows a good progression. A search of the area found no other irons. Good GPS position.

I recommend that this found 3/4" iron pipe be accepted as the SE corner of Section 31 of Green Oak Township.
