

West 1/4 Corner, Section 24, T1N-R6E, Green Oak Township, Livingston County, Michigan.


Found spike in 3/4" I.D. Pipe 1/2 foot ± below gravel surface and 4 feet ± west of centerline of Peer Road. This corner is open for G.P.S. There is no evidence of other corners.

This corner was set by Atwell-Hicks on November 19, 1952 (see pages 11 thru 14). Note witness on field notes Page 11. A 24" B. Oak west 97.9 feet coincides with Washtenaw Engineering witness S 86° W 97.9 feet 24" Oak on page 7 of this dossier. There may be some confusion on witnesses documented by Norman Fahrner's Act 74's and Washtenaw Engineering surveys, but all evidence points to 1" iron pipe raised with boat spike as the west 1/4 of Section 24.

Conclusion:

We find the boat spike set by Norman Fahrner in the 1" pipe which was set by Atwell-Hicks to be the west 1/4 corner of said Section 24 and recommend its approval.
