# SUMMARY M-3

Northeast Corner, Section 12, Green Oak Township, Livingston County, Michigan.

Corner set by Alex Holmes in 1816. No witnesses were recorded in County Surveyors Field Notes.

A June 1955 survey by Omar E. McNutt records Southeast corner, Section 1, Green Oak Township along north line of Section 12, recorded 2650.75 feet.

On November 16, 1956, Marion Fox platted "Blood Farms Subdivision" and calls for a 4" Iron pipe fence post at N.E. Corner, Section 12, Green Oak Township.

In 1964, Wynn W. Wakenhut shows the M-3 but does not witness or indicate the monument at M-3. He also finds a 4" steel corner post in concrete and calls it the N.W. Corner, Section 7, Lyon Township. A jog of 248.6 feet to the Southwest Corner of Section 6, Lyon township, Oakland County is also noted.

A Postiff survey in 1969 matches the McNutt survey of 1955.

An October 30, 1972, recorded survey by Charles Wilson and an October 16, 1972 recorded survey by George Kattouah find the N.E. Corner, Section 12, 164.94 feet North of Silver Lake Road and 11.79 feet Easterly along the centerline of said road from east line of Section Southerly. (Both of these surveys call out this point incorrectly as this is A-3 as shown on the Wakenhut survey).

James M. Potts, May 11, 1989, survey denotes straight line on Dixboro Road Northerly to found 1" iron rod in Silver Lake Road and then continuing 165.0 feet North to N.W. corner, section 7, Lyon Township.

A Kostecke survey in 1996 matches the 1955 McNutt and 1969 Postiff surveys.

#### **WITNESSES**

On 2-10-89, Greg Ash recorded an Act 74 Certificate. None of these witness points are in nor do they appear to have ever been in.

Boss Engineering matches the Kostecke survey witnesses approx. The triple trees used by Kostecke are now double trees (much has been disturbed in this area). The original points at M-3 and A-3 Lyon Twp. are also gone, the neighbors have been in dispute for many years and these points have been removed.

## **DISTANCES**

The points to the North (McNutt, Postiff and Kostecke) have been located and check quite well. The points to the South (A-3) and to the Centerline of Silver Lake Road also check (Wakenhut, McNutt, Kostecke). As does the measurement from M-3 to M-4 with all surveys (Wakenhut, Ash, Kostecke and Boss).

This point is not open to GPS.

### RECOMMENDATION

We recommend using the point reestablished by Boss Engineering at the location of the McNutt, Wakenhut, Postiff, and Kostecke Surveys.
