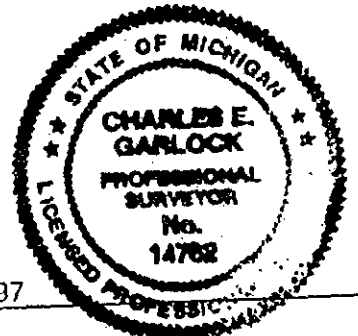

GLO SURVEY DATED APRIL 15, 1825 BY S SIBLEY AND NONE OF THE GLO WITNESSES REMAIN.

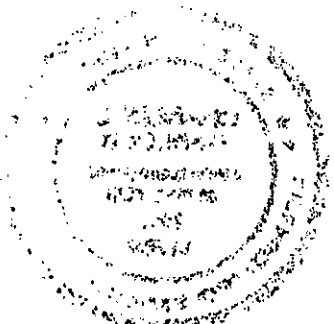
BULLOCK'S 1895 WITNESS IS GONE.

BENTON IN 1976 FOUND A SPIKE ON THE NORTH EDGE OF SCHAFER ROAD AND ON THE CENTERLINE OF PINGREE ROAD TO THE NORTH AND SET A 3/4" IRON ROD, NONE OF HIS WITNESSES REMAIN, BUT HIS DISTANCES NORTH, EAST AND WEST CHECK WITH OTHER SURVEYORS. HUGHES WITNESSES WERE FOUND AND THEY CHECK WITH THE BENTON IRON, WE ALSO FOUND THE PUTNAM TWP. CORNER 7.99 TO THE EAST AND ON THE SOUTH TOWNSHIP LINE, GLO COMPS AT 2.64 EAST. MEASURES WEST ARE: 2485.52=BENTON '78, 2485.56=BOSS '89 AND GLO IS 2485.56; NORTH ARE 2600.39 = BENTON, HUGHES AND GARLOCK; EAST ARE 2610.96=FAIRCHILD 1851, 2649.68=BENTON '84, 2649.53=GARLOCK '96, 2649.55=HUGHES '95 AND WE HAD 2649.53 IN '97. IRON IS LOCATED IN A GRAVEL ROAD INTERSECTION AND A GOOD GPS SITE. WE RECOMMEND THE FOUND BENTON IRON AS THE TRUE B-13
