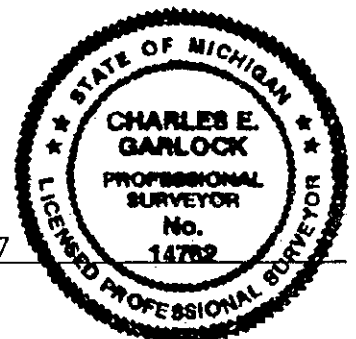

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
FD. 1 1/4" THICK WALL GAS PIPE AS PER GH DUNNING 1912 WITNESSES ON THE NORTH EDGE OF GRAVEL ROAD CURVING TO THE SW'LY, TOP OF PIPE THAT WAS 48" LONG WAS BENT BADLY.

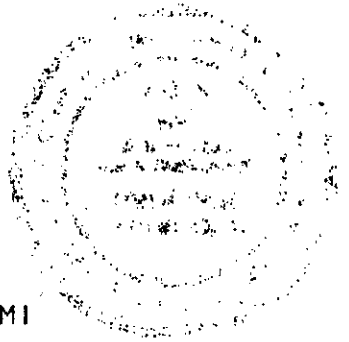

CORNER SUMMARY

F-13: S 1/4 COR. SEC. 33 T2N-R4E, MARION TWP. LIV. CO. MI

GLO SURVEY DATED APRIL 15, 1825 BY S SIBLEY AND NONE OF THE GLO WITNESSES REMAIN.

BULLOCKS 1878 AND 1902 WITNESS TREES ARE GONE. DUNNINGS 1912 WITNESSES TO 3 TREES REMAIN AND THEY CHECK TO A FOUND 1 1/4" GAS PIPE AS DUNNING HAD DESCRIBED. BENTON IN '77 & '78 CALLED THE GAS PIPE A 1/2" IRON PIPE AS DID BOSS IN '87; BOTH SETS OF WITNESSES WERE TO THE SAME TREES AND DISTANCES THE SAME AND THEY INTERSECTED WITH THE FOUND 1 1/4" GAS PIPE LOCATED -0.6' AND ON THE NORTH EDGE OF THE GRAVEL ROAD IN A CURVE SW'LY. BRADYS WITNESSES HE CALLED F-13 ACTUALLY WERE TO PUTNAM TWPS. F-1; J SMITHS WITNESSES WERE TO ANOTHER CORNER, SOMEWHERE ??? AND D HUGHES WITNESSED F-1 OF PUTNAM TWP. FOR A JOB IN PUTNAM AND ALSO LISTED F-13 MARION AS BEING 13.30' WEST OF F-1. DUNNINGS GAS PIPE THAT WE FOUND LINED WITH A VERY OLD FENCE LINE AND HEDGE ROW TO THE NORTH, THE PUTNAM COR. F-1 WAS FOUND AND LOCATED ON THE SOUTH TWP. LINE EAST 13.41', BUT GLO JOG COMPUTES TO BE WEST 23.10'. BECAUSE OF OVERHANGING TREES THE SITE IS NOT SUITABLE FOR GPS. PREVIOUS SURVEYORS MEASURED WEST: 2651.88 = OLD RECORDS, 2651.22 = DUNNING '12, 2667.94 = MUNSELL '48 AND WE HAD 2644.03, MEASURED THIS TWICE AS A DOUBLE CHECK. MEASURES EAST ARE: 2651.88 = OLD RECORDS, 2650.56 = BENTON '68, 2650.46 = BENTON '77, 2650.04 = BOSS '87 & '91, 2650.02' = GARLOCK '96 AND WE HAD 2650.03. WE RECOMMEND THE CONTINUED USE OF DUNNINGS GAS PIPE AS FOUND FOR F-13.
