Found $\frac{1}{2}$ iron rod with Boss Engineering cap 354.29' East of spike in center-line of Pinckney Rd. and in East-West hedge-row with the remains of an old East-West fence on the ground. Found no occupation to North or South because land on either side of East-West line was owned by the same people for many years in Sections 25 and 26 North and Sections 35 and 36 South. Found no old County Surveyor witnesses in County Surveyor records. Earliest known reference to Corner was by L.W. Munsell in 1954 when he measured 356'± from the old center-line of Pinckney Rd. to a fence post. In 1961 when he returned to survey the reconstruction of Pinckney Rd. he measured 296.0' from the center-line of the road to a point called SE Corner Sec. 26, the same point shown on highway plans. A 1967 survey by L.W. Munsell also had 296.0' from the new centerline of Pinckney Rd. About 1970 a Boss Engineering survey called for the NW Corner to be 354.29' East of the center-line of Pinckney Rd. (new center-line: it was moved East in 1964 about 3-4 feet) where L.W. Munsell originally had 356'± from the old center-line of Pinckney Rd. in 1954. With the iron in the present location by Boss Engineering measures East are: 2613.57' to N 1/4 Cor. Sec. 36 and continuing 2621.63' to the NE Corner totaling 5235.20'. GLO notes call for 5240.4' and interpolation of old County Surveyor notes call for 2600.4' from NW Corner to N 1/4 Corner and continuing 2637.36' to the NE Corner totaling 5237.76' Now going West into Section 35 the distance from the NW Corner Corner and Co Sec. 36 to N 1/4 Cor. Sec. 35 is 2587.18' and continuing to the NW Cor. Sec. 35 2590.4' totaling 5177.58'; GLO is 5175.72'. Therefore I recommend the present location for the NW Corner of Sec. 36 Marion Twp. Corner is in a hedge East and West, open to the North and buildings to the South.
