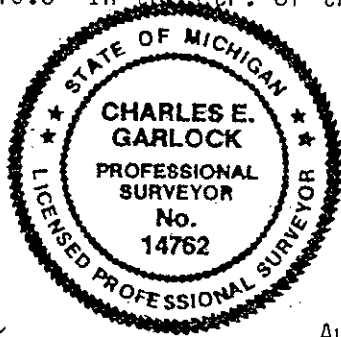

GLO notes dated April 15, 1825 by S. Sibley, D.S.

Found no records of this Corner in any of the County Surveyor records in the Court House or my office. Found a 1/2" I. Rod set by PL Benton with his cap at the E 1/4 corner of Section 24 Marion Twp. and found a very old corner post with fences to the North, South and West; also at 222.21 feet to the North I found a corner post for the W 1/4 corner of Section 19 Genoa Twp. GLO jog calcs at 240.90'. Measured 2634.35' North to the NE Corner Sec. 24 and 2658.78' South to the SE Corner Sec. 24 from the E 1/4 cor. All known surveys by P.L. Benton, Boss Engineering and myself have used this point as the 1/4 Corner as occupied. Area is wooded on the East side of the Twp. line to the North and South and fairly wooded to the SW; only the NW is open.

Found no other irons in the area.
