## SUMMARY

K-9 SOUTHWEST CORNER SECTION 24, T2N-R5E, GENOA TOWNSHIP, LIVINGSTON COUNTY, MICHIGAN.

This Section originally Surveyed by S. Sibley in 1823. Corner Witnessed in 1880 by M.W. Bullock and again Witnessed by Grant H. Dunning in 1915.

Found 1/2" inch Iron Rod 50' feet  $\pm$  Northeasterly of existing edge of asphalt at intersection of Bauer Road and Challis Road. 1 foot  $\pm$  East of edge of gravel on Bauer Road.

Measured to witnesses found. Measured to witnesses found. Found 3 of 3 Garlock Witnesses and they checked, pages 12, 14, 17, 18, 20, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 28. Found 5 of 5 Garlock Witnesses checked, page 34.

Found 3 of 3 Herbert Avey Act 74 witnesses checked, page 13.

Found 3 of 3 Boss Engineering witnesses checked, page 27, 30, 36 and 37.

Found 2 of 3 Larry Bryan witnesses checked, page 32. Second witness should read 41.60 (not 46.10).

Southeast Quadrant open to G.P.S. and existing Intersection of Roads. Medium to heavy woods cover other 3 Quadrants.

Distances from the West vary between 2655.81' feet to 2656.13' Distances from South vary between 2659.46' feet to 2661.56' feet. There are no comparisons East or North of K-9.

Conclusion: No other Irons in area. Witnesses all check from 4 Land Surveyors records. Disparity in distances are minimal and tolerable; therefore, we find that the 1/2" inch Iron is the correct S.W. Corner of Section 24.
