GLO SURVEY DATED APRIL 15, 1825 BY S SIBLEY AND NONE OF THE
WITNESSES REMAIN.

NEXT KNOWN WITNESSES ARE 1877 AND 78 BY E GRANT, M BULLOCK IN
1882, NONE OF WHICH REMAIN TODAY. C GORDON FOUND A BOLT IN STONE,
DATE UNKNOWN. IN 1959 & 60 L MUNSELL FOUND THE BOLT IN STONE AS I
DID IN 1981 WHEN IT WAS RAISED WITH A RR SPIKE. ONE WITNESS TO A
SYCAMORE BY C GORDON REMAINS TODAY AND STILL CHECKS. ABOUT 1972 C
WILSON SET A SECOND RR SPIKE 1.5 FEET WEST AND 0.5 FEET SOUTH OF
THE CORNER GORDON, MUNSELL, BENTON, HUGHES AND MYSELF HAVE USED.
I FOUND TWO ACT '74'S RECORDED, MINE AND C WILSON'S AND ONE ACT
132. BENTON MEASURED NORTH 2651.97 TO THE NW COR. SECTION 24,
HUGHES HAD 2651.80 AND I HAD 2651.74; I MEASURED SOUTH 2648.42
TO THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 24 AND EAST 5243.71 TO THE EAST 1/4 OF
SECTION 24. THIS YEAR I FOUND THE RR SPIKE AT -0.5 FEET AND
DIRECTLY UNDER IT THE BOLT WITH A 1" TO 1 1/4" SQUARE HEAD SET IN
STONE AS PER C GORDON'S NOTES, THE C WILSON RR SPIKE WAS GONE. THE
CORNER IS IN THE INTERSECTION OF LAYTON AND SMITH ROADS (GRAVEL)
AND FAIRLY OPEN IN ALL DIRECTIONS. FOUND NO OTHER IRONS IN THE
AREA.
