GLO SURVEY IS DATED APRIL 15, 1825 BY S SIBLEY AND FOUND NONE OF THE GLO WITNESSES REMAIN TODAY.

EARLIST KNOWN WITNESS SINCE THE GLO SURVEY IS 1874 BY MW BULLOCK, COUNTY SURVEYOR. NEXT KNOWN SURVEY WAS BY CW GORDON, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN 1953, WHEN HE RETRACED THE BOUNDARIES OF SEVERAL PARCELS AND RECORDED A DISTANCE OF 472 FT EAST FROM THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF MICHIGAN AVE. (66 FT. WIDE) TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36. LW MUNSELL IN 1957 ALSO HAD 472 FEET FROM THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF MICHIGAN AVE, TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER. ABOUT THIS TIME CW GORDON & LW MUNSELL RECORDED THE PLATS OF NORTHLAND, L7PG7 AND ASSESSOR'S PLAT NO.9, L6 PG41-43, USING SAID 1/4 CORNER AS THE POINT OF BEGINNING AND SET A CONCRETE MONUMENT FOR THE 1/4 I FOUND THE CONCRETE MONUMENT AT SAID 1/4 CORNER THAT MATCHED THE WORKS OF GORDON AND MUNSELL, ALSO FOUND RIBBON TIED TO THE MONUMENT BY OTHERS. THE 1/4 CORNER LIES IN A SWAMP AREA WITH REMAINS OF A FENCE LINE FROM THE WEST TO THE EDGE OF THE SWAMP AND A LINE OF TREES TO THE NORTH STARTING AT THE EDGE OF THE SWAMP. FOUND NO SIGNS OF OCCUPATION TO THE EAST OR SOUTH, ALTHOUGH THERE IS A FENCE RUNNING EAST-WEST NEAR THE SHORE LINE OF HOWELL LAKE, BETWEEN THE CITY PARK AND LAKEVIEW CEMETERY WHICH IS SUPPOSED TO BE ON THE NORTH SECTION LINE. FOUND NO SIGNS OF ANOTHER IRON IN AREA IS WOODED TO THE WEST & SOUTH AND FAIRLY OPEN TO THE AREA. THE NORTH AND EAST. MEAS'D 2634.78 FT. WEST TO THE NORTHWEST SECTION CORNER AND CALC'D 5291.10 FT. SOUTH TO THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER. DID NOT FIND ANY ACT 74'S OR ACT 132'S RECORDED REGARDS THIS CORNER.
