M-4: E 1/4 COR. SEC. 12, T3N-R4E, HOWELL TWP., LIVINGSTON CO $\frac{\hbar}{32}$ ·MI

GLO SURVEY DATED APRIL 15TH, 1825 BY S. SIBLEY AND NONE OF THE GLO WITNESSES REMAIN.

M. BULLOCK IN 1880 WITNESSED THIS CORNER TO AN 18" CHERRY WHICH IS NOW GONE. THE NEXT KNOWN ACTIVITY WAS A 1933/1942 C. GORDON SURVEY WHICH INDICATES HE FOUND THE E. 1/4 POST BUT NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT IS GIVEN. FOLLOWING THIS IN 1964 C. GARLOCK WHILE WORKING FOR L. MUNSELL SET A 1/2" X 16" IRON ROD BASED ON THE C. GORDON SURVEY AND ESTABLISHED A R/W IRON AT 33' TO THE WEST AND SET SPIKES ON THE E-W 1/4 LINE EVERY 200'. WITNESSES WERE ESTABLISHED AT THE TIME, ONE BEING S05°W, 70.4' TO THE CENTER OF A 6" POPLAR. THE NEXT ACTIVITY WAS IN 1981 WHEN BOSS ENG. RECORDED A SURVEY WITH WITNESSES MATCHING THE BEARING AND DISTANCE TO THE POPLAR TREE AND TO THE 1/2" IRON ROD TO THE WEST. ALSO, BOSS RECORDED THE W 1/4 COR. SEC. 7, T3N-R5E AS BEING A 1/2" IRON ROD NO2°E, 103.18' FROM M-4. IN 1986 C. GARLOCK FOUND THE 1/2" IRON ROD BASED ON THE POPLAR TREE, WHICH WAS NOW 26" IN DIAMETER AND THE 1/2" IRON ROD AT THE R/W. C. GARLOCK FOUND THE IRON BENT SO HE REPLACED IT WITH A 1/2" CAPPED IRON ROD AS HE INDICATED ON HIS CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY. IN 1989 AND 1990 BOSS ENG. RECORDED THE CORNER ON CERTIFICATES OF SURVEY AS BEING A 1/2" IRON AND LISTED THE SAME WITNESSES AS 1981 BUT A JOG DISTANCE OF 113.40'. IN 1992 DURING A SURVEY OF SEC. 7, T3N-R5E, DESINE INC. WITNESSED THE W 1/4 COR. SEC. 7 TO THE ABOVE MENTIONED POPLAR/COTTONWOOD (NOW 36" IN DIAMETER) AT S05°W, 173.68'. SUBTRACTING THE 1986 GARLOCK MEASUREMENT OF 70.4' WOULD GIVE A GLO JOG OF ABOUT 103.3'. THE LAST LOCATED INFORMATION IS A 1995 BOSS ENG. CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY WHICH INDICATES A FOUND 1/2" IRON AND LISTS THE SAME WITNESSES AS PREVIOUS SURVEYS.

DURING OUR FIELD RESEARCH WE LOCATED A BENT 1/2" IRON ROD NEAR THE WEST EDGE OF FISHER ROAD BY MEASURING FROM THE NOW 42" POPLAR AND THE RIGHT OF WAY IRON ESTABLISHED BY GARLOCK IN 1964. THIS BENT IRON WAS REPLACED WITH ANOTHER 1/2" IRON ROD. WE ALSO FOUND THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 7, T3N-R5E 103.10' NORTH OF THIS IRON ROD. THE MEASUREMENTS THAT WE COLLECTED IN THE FIELD WERE 2641.99' NORTH AND 2653.99' SOUTH.

COMPARATIVE MEASURES WERE: NORTH - 2642.31' BOSS, 2649.24' BULLOCK,
2642.41' BENTON; SOUTH - 2649.24' BULLOCK, 2653.93' BOSS. THE LOCATION IS ONLY A FAIR GPS SITE BECAUSE OF TREE COVER TO THE NORTHWEST. WE RECOMMEND THE RESET 1/2" IRON'ROD BE ACCEPTED AS A FAITHFULL PERPETUATION OF THE ORIGINAL GLO CORNER BASED ON THE CHAIN OF HISTORY DATING BACK TO THE C. GORDON 1/4 POST AND THE OCCUPATION LINE ESTABLISHED IN 1964.
