NEXT KNOWN ACTIVITY WAS BY M BULLOCK IN 1874 AND G DUNNING IN 1910 WHEN THEY WITNESSED THIS CORNER AND IN 1924 WHEN G DUNNING RECORDED THE PLAT OF "FAIRLAWN BEACH" (L2 PG 39) AND SHOWED THE CORNER TO BE NORTH 61.50 FEET OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SAID PLAT. WE FOUND THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF "FAIRLAWN BEACH" TO BE 61.50 FEET SOUTH OF THE FOUND 1/4 CORNER. SINCE THE RECORDING OF THE PLAT, WE FOUND SIMILAR WITNESSES TO SEVERAL REMAINING TREES BY THE FOLLOWING SURVEYORS: L MUNSELL, C WILSON, P BENTON, M MAHIEU, T TIETSEMA AND MYSELF AND ALL REMAINING WITNESSES ALSO CHECK TO THE FOUND 1/2" I. PIPE SET ON TOP OF A 1" I. PIPE. FOUND TWO ACT 74'S RECORDED BUT NO ACT 132'S. MEASURES TO THE NORTH OF 2650.80 BY STONEROCK AND 2648.94 BY MYSELF. MEASURE WEST OF 2641.32 BY OLD COUNTY SURVEY RECORDS TO THE CENTER OF SECTION, NONE TO THE SOUTH, BECAUSE CORNER IS NOW IN THE LAKE. FOUND NO RECORD OF THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30 OCEOLA TOWNSHIP, BUT PLACEMENT OF THE CORNER FROM GLO RECORDS WOULD BE 2.64 FEET SOUTH OF THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25 HOWELL TOWNSHIP, THEREFORE I BELIEVE THE HOWELL CORNER HAS BEEN USED AS COMMON WITH OCEOLA TOWNSHIP. CORNER IS LOCATED ABOUT 24 FEET SOUTH OF THE CENTERLINE OF M-59 IN THE MOWED SHOULDER AND APPEARS TO BE A GOOD SITE FOR GPS.


