

H-13 T3N - R5E: South 1/4 Corner, Section 34, Oceola Township

We found a 1/2" iron in Golf Club Road. There is fence and a posssible tree row to the north starting north of the roadside drainage ditch, and occupation to the south at the closing corner. This corner was reported as being set by Holmes in 1816 for the GLO. There are Act 74s filed by Wilson(1972), Boss(1972) and Defenderfer(1993) and the witnesses still check well. The closing corner for Genoa falls 97.02 feet west of H-13. All measures since 1975 compare well with current distances. A sweep of the area near this location did not reveal any other corner markers. The current position seems to be a perpetuation of the location witnessed by Wilson in 1972. Considering the perpetuation of this corner since 1972 and the universal acceptance of this position by local surveyors I recommend acceptance of the current location to be replaced by a standard Livingston County Remonumentation monument. This corner is masked for GPS occupation in the summer by trees but may be occupiable with careful pre-planning.
