



We found a 1/2" iron with cap #16931 (Harry Kemnitz) in the center of an old fence post hole surrounded with stones. There are fences running north, south, east, and west from this corner. The corner was originally recorded as being set by Sibley in 1823 for the GLO. There is an Act 74 filed by Charles Wilson in 1973, with witnesses matching the present measure. A sweep of the area near the iron did not reveal any other corner markers. This corner is in a wooded area and would not be usable as a GPS point. I recommend accepting K-08, the West 1/4 Corner of Section 24, Oceola at the location as ep ers. a GPS section 2 the iron. JACK K. SMITH PROFESSION' SURVEY' is presently monumented by the iron.
