

Found 2" well point with 1/2" rod in center well^down about l' below the surface of gravel roadway with top of 1/2" rod near surface of roadway.

Boss, Garlock, and Munsell all used the same witnesses, Pages 6B,7A,8B,10 and 12 this dossier. We found an old 36" stamp at the location of the \$50°W, 53.6' 36" Oak witness. The 22" Apple N53°W, 61.9' was gone. Found a 10" Hickory N76°E, 109.5', but couldn't find the nail, but distance checked to approximately centerline of tree. Found a hole in the ground at the location of the 2" sign post \$10E, 28.3' and distance checked.

Distances from SE corner to S 1/4 corner of said Section 36 was measured as 2644.55' by Anderson. The distance from SE corner to the East 1/4 corner of said Section 36 is 2645.91' per Boss Survey, Pages 6A,7A, and 8A this dossier. Pike measured 2645.33' to West 1/4 corner of Section 31, T4N-R6E, Tyrone Township, Boundary survey, Page ±2,7 this dossier. Boss also shows the West 1/4 corner of said Section 31, 6.84 South of the East 1/4 Corner of said Section 36. Therefore Boss and Pike are measuring to the same corner, but Pike calling it the West 1/4 Corner of said Section 31 and Boss calling it the East 1/4 corner of said Section 36.

Found old tree line running to the South. Gravel road (McGuire) running to the North and gravel road (Allen Road) running East and West. No other old occupation. Corner fell 7'- North of centerline of Allen Road and 7'- East of centerline of McGuire Road.
