

L-05 T3N - R6E: NORTH 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 13, HARTLAND TOWNSHIP

We found a 1/2" iron on the centerline of Hibner Road (gravel). There is very weak occupation to the north. The corner was originally recorded as being set by S. Sibley in 1823. This corner is shown on a survey from 1878/1879 by Teller with two witnesses (now gone) in which he calls for the setting of the corner on the North line at 1/2 distance between the NW and NE Corners (the current corner is 8 feet west of 1/2 distance). Boss Engineering calls for a distance of 2735.08 feet to the Northeast Corner in 1982 but reports a distance of 2733.49 feet in 1983 which matches current measure. There are no Act 74s recorded for the Corner at the present time. We dug this iron up and excavated to undisturbed soil but found no other corner evidence. A sweep of the area did not reveal any additional irons. This corner is open for GPS occupation. I recommend accepting L-05, the North 1/4 Corner of Section 13, at the location as is presently monumented.
