#### MONUMENTATION

We found a 1/2" iron near the centerline of Tipsico Lake Road (gravel). The corner was originally recorded as being set by S. Sibley in 1823.

This corner is shown as set by Bullock in 1870 at 1/2 distance on line. One witness from 1965 by Albright still checks and two of the 1972 Boss witnesses still check. We did not locate a closing corner for Highland Township.

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Bullock measure of 1870 was 2648.58 feet to the north and south. Current measure is 2648.08 to the north and 2651.64 feet to the south. The corner is close to agreement with line between M-05 and the westerly of two irons marking M-03. Brad Thompson measured 2648.19 feet to M-03, Boss measured 2651.60 feet south to M-05 and Albright measured 2652.2 feet to M-05 in 1965.

#### OCCUPATION

The corner is near the centerline of Tipsico Lake Road and fits well with a tree row to the east which may be why no closing corner was found. There are buried fence pieces to the west but no other decent occupation.

A sweep of the area did not reveal any additional irons and there was no evidence that any other corner position has been used. This corner can be used for GPS without much problem.

### RECORDATION

This corner has Act 74s filed by Oscar Boss, Marvin Pike and Brad Thompson and is used on 3 Act 132s of record.

## SUMMARY

Based on the apparent perpetuation of the corner for the past 30 years and the usage of the corner for all surveys that could be acquired, I recommend the acceptance of M-04, the East 1/4 Corner of Section 12, Hartland Township at the location as is presently monumented by the 1/2" iron.
