- FIELD 6-21-1996 DARRELL D. HUGHES AND ASSOCIATES, FOWLERVILLE.
- Found 1/2" iron rerod 0.6' below gravel road grade, at centerline of Stow and Moyer Roads. Measures West to B-10, South to C-11 and North to C-9 agree with past measures. One common witness remains from 1972 (utility pole). Recent surveyors who have used this point are Boss, Garlock, CHMP and Hughes. I recommend the acceptance of this iron for the location of C-10. All quadrants open for GPS except to Southeast.
- 1825 Sylvester Sibley, Deputy U.S. Surveyor sets corner "North between 29 and 30...40.00 chains, set 1/4 sec. post". (P.7-7A)
- 1872 Miles Bullock divides Section 29, "from the SW corner north 40.28 chains (2658.48') to W 1/4 cor. and north the NE corner 40.34 chains (2662.44')" both in close accord with present measures. (P.8-8A)
- 1972 Survey by Garlock. No witness' shown, Iron 33' east not found. Measures South to C-11 (2660.68'). (P.9)
- 1973-1974 Survey by Oscar Boss. Seven corners used to perform survey, witness' shown for only four. C-10 not witnessed. (P.10-10C)
- 1975 Piotrowski files Act 74 in 1977 (could not find matching survey) "fd. 3/8" iron rod". (P.11)
- 1976 Piotrowski survey uses corner and shows witness'. (P.12)
- 1977 Miller (CHMP) uses corner in survey, shows witness'. (P.13)
- 1981~&~1991~ Surveys by Garlock use and witness corner. Measures South to C-11 both 2660.13'. P.14 & P.19)
- 1986 Survey by Hughes. Measures agree North to C-9. (P.15)
- 1987 Survey by Hughes. Copied witness' from 1986. (P.16-16A)
- 1989 Survey by Hughes. Copied witness' from 1986. (P.17-17A)
- 1990 Survey by Jacobs (JCK Assoc.) no witness shown on survey, found one mail/tag with JCK number. No witness' shown in their field notes. However measures agree North to C-9 and West to B-10. (P.18)
- 1994 Survey by Hughes. New witness' and agree with old. (P.20-20A)
