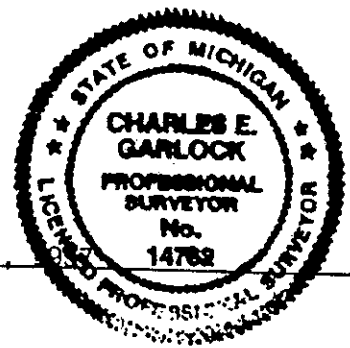

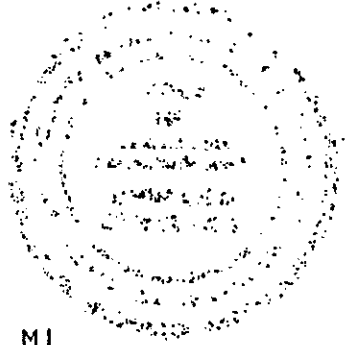

CORNER SUMMARY

M-2: E 1/4 COR. SEC. 1 T4N-R3E, CONWAY TWP. LIV. CO. MI

GLO SURVEY DATED APRIL 15, 1825 BY S. SIBLEY AND NONE OF THE GLO WITNESSES REMAIN.

I. TELLER IN 1877 WITNESSED THIS CORNER AND TREE IS GONE. NEXT KNOWN ACTIVITY WAS IN 1972 WHEN BOSS ENGR. FOUND A 1/2" I. ROD, FOLLOWED BY GARLOCK IN 1976, AF MILLER IN 1977, CHMP 1981 AND D HUGHES IN 1989, ALL USING THE SAME 1/2" I. ROD. REMAINING WITNESSES OF THE ABOVE SURVEYORS CHECK TO THE FOUND IRON THAT IS LOCATED ON THE CENTERLINE OF ROADS NORTH, SOUTH AND WEST. PIOTROWSKI IN 1973 AND RL SMITH IN 1979 USED THIS CORNER FOR THE W 1/4 COR. IN COHOCTAH TWP., BUT GLO JOG COMPUTES TO A POINT 14.19 FEET TO THE SOUTH. A SEARCH OF THE AREA DID NOT TURN UP ANY OTHER IRONS. THE LAND IN COHOCTAH TWP. IS OWNED BY THE SAME PARTY IN BOTH QUARTERS AND NO OCCUPATION IS TO BE FOUND TO THE EAST. MEASURE SOUTH BY I TELLER IN 1877 WAS 2648.58 FEET AND OUR MEASURE NOW IS 2647.07 FEET. HUGHES, CHMP AND AMERICAN CIVIL ENGRS. ALL MEASURED 2640.90' BUT TO A DIFFERENT IRON. CORNER IS LOCATED IN A GRAVEL ROAD "T" INTERSECTION AND IS A GOOD POINT FOR A GPS STATION.

I RECOMMEND THE FOUND 1/2" I ROD AS THE CORRECT CORNER.
