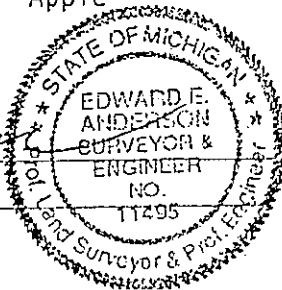

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SUMMARY

May 2, 1995

F-13 S. 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33, T4N-R6E, TYRONE TOWNSHIP,  
LIVINGSTON COUNTY, MICHIGAN.

Found 1/2" iron in centerline of Parshallville Road (gravel)

Checked and measured to witnesses we found. Found all of Albright witnesses and they checked. We looked for the N 1/4 corner of Section 4, T3N-R6E, and did not find any iron; however, there is an old fence line running to the south, which if extended north to the intersection of the north line of said Section 4, falls approximately 1/2 way between the NE and the NW corners of said Section 4 and said intersection falls 21' to the east of the South 1/4 corner of said Section 33, which matches close to the job of 22.77' when subtracting the G.L.O. jogs at the NE and NW corners of said Section 4 and dividing by two. See sheet 8 of this dossier.

Distance from the S 1/4 corner to the SE corner of said Section 33 is 2653.68' on Albright survey, page 9 this dossier.

Distance from the S 1/4 corner to the S.W. corner of said Section 33 is 2653.68' on Albright survey, pages 9 thru 12 this dossier.

Made a clean sweep of immediate area and found no additional corners or irons.

Gravel roads running east and west. Road rises to the west and falls to the east.

Terrain is open to the south and farm buildings to the north.

Old fence and tree line to the north.

Poor location for G.P.S.

Came to the conclusion that the 1/2" iron we found is the correct South 1/4 corner of said Section 33.
