- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- (16) Recovered a 1/2" rebar encased in a 4" concrete monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the Cedar NW NBT, good condition, and the Aspen NE NBT, now dead. A 1" iron pipe is North 2622.43' in agreement with the 1996 record. I note that the 1" pipe does not mark the position for corner I5, according to record for I5 found in Book E Page 371. I accept the concrete monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
