B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: (1-Sec.12) Buckler's monument was not recovered. Remonumented the corner with a 1"x36" iron pipe capped with a plastic cap stamped "MICH DMR ES 33986". Placed the pipe on a straight line between monumented government corners 1320.89" east and west. Corner falls in center of E-M road. Found Buckler's two mitness trees in place and at record bearing and distance from the remonumented corner.
