

(15-Sec. 31) West 1/16 corner between Section 31 T42N-R11W and Section 6 T41N-R11W. Corner established in 1969 by Billy D. Buckler in line with fence to north and 29.0° South of fence corner. Buried 1.25"x30" iron pipe in road, at corner. 18° H. Maple N67E 72.8°. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C12) Found and accepted Babbitt's monument as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from his 1983 witnesses, all in good condition.
