(813) Quarter corner common to Section 3: T42M-R11M and Section 6 T41M-R11M. Corner replaced in 1969 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS in center of E-W road and between two Fence Corners. Buried 1"x36" iron pipe, 6" Cedar S40E 37.5', 8" Cedar S22W 53.7'. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(AL3) Found Buckler's DNR monument buried just morth of the north edge of road, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from this N. Pine and Cedar NW NBTs. Re-Marked top blaze on these two witnesses, placed measuring nails in them, and marked two new bearing trees as described below. The Cedar SE HBT has been cut.

(813) Found Buckler's monument, as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from his SE cedar HBT. The other NOT has been cut. Also recovered 3 additional MOTs marked with blazes and scribing in 1903. Re-marked top blazes and placed measuring nails in all remaining trees as described below. The corner monument falls in the center of E-W road.
