B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(D9) Original post and accessories not recovered. Found no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. A spring brook, matching the description in the original record, was found 1650' West of the position determined for this corner (27' longer than record). I was rejuctant to rely upon the random line notes of this particular deputy surveyor for the determination of the original corner position and, therefore, did not regard the stream call as acceptable evidence of the position of the corner. Determined the original corner to be lost and reestablished the corner by single proportionate measurement to the original record, on a line of mean true bearing between Section corners 2573.57 ft. east and west. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1 IDx36 iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark and D.Lampela, Newberry District Office.

Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails in the following: 12' Maple S58E-15.85' 1/48 NBT' 14' Vaple S17W 18.0' 1/48 NBT' 5' Maple N45W 41.15' 1/48 NBT' 8' Maple N58E 25.85' 1/48 NBT' Placed a 4' squared and scribed cedar post adjacent.
