

Reestablished the corner midway and on a line of mean true bearing between monumented section corners 2655.0' East and West. At the position for the corner I placed a 1" ID x 36" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. I buried the manument at the corner, which falls in the northerly wheel track of an E-M trail. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark and M.Feldpausch, Newberry District Office.
