

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- 1993: Found 2½" x 3' aluminum monument with a 3" aluminum cap stamped to identify the corner. Set in 1989 by Richard L. Hays to replace a "T" iron previously set by Mary Feindt in 1973.
