## A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(th) Quarter corner common to Sections 25-36. Corner previously recorded in 1986 by Gerald Miggins, RLS as follows: "Re-witnessed corner as set by Billy O. Buckler, R.L.S. 3-27-69. DMR monument placed over 1 1/4" pipe. 6" Cedar S44E 5.3', 12" Tamarack M37E 5.6', 10" Tamarack 526N 32.1', 4" Cedar N37N B.75'".

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(L11) Found the monument described by Miggins and Buckler at record bearing and distance from Miggins mitnesses. Suried the DNR monument, a 1" ID iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast alumium tablet, below the surface of the old grade in which it falls. Marked new witnesses as described below. Revisited the corner location in May, 1995 and noted that both of Wiggin's cedar NBTs have been destroyed. Placed a location post with tag East 10.0' from the monument.

## C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(tll) i" pipe with 4" aluminum cap, buried with 1 1/4° pipe. Blazed, scribed, and placed measuring nails in the following: 12" Tamarack #378 5.6' (1986 witness) 10" Tamarack S26M 32.55'(1986 witness) 6" Cedar 578W 48.6" "1/45 NBT" 3" Tamarack S41W 33.4" 1/45 NBT" 3" Cedar N60W 37.7" "1/45 NBT" Bearings are magnetic.
