

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
(D5) Quarter corner common to Sections 8-17. Corner established in 1849 by William Ives: "...40.08 Set of section post. Fir 6 S17E 12, Fir 7 H12W 23". Local land owner Mr. Elmer Brown told me that, prior to 1969, T.L. Jackson monumented this corner during a survey for Mr. Brown. He said that T.L. Jackson placed an "iron peg" which Mr. Brown subsequently replaced with an iron pipe.
(11-Sec. 8) Southwest 1/16 corner, Section 8. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(D5) Original post and accessories were not recovered. Recovered a 1° iron pipe located in the intersection of fence lines existing to the North, South, East and Mest. Mr. Elber Brown says that this pipe is the one he placed at T.L. Jackson's location. My measurements show that the pipe is 2.4° East and 25.9' South of the position proportionate to the original record. I accept the pipe as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. At the position of the pipe I placed a 1°IDx36° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark, Newberry District Office.

(11-Sec. 8) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/16 corners. Only those South and East of this position are monumented. At the position for the corner I placed a 1°IDx36° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark, Newberry District Office.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

[D5] Set 1° iron pipe with 4" HDHR cap. (11) Set 1° pipe with 4" HDHR cap.

(D5) Set 1" iron pipe with 4" MDNR cap. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails in the following: in the following: "SN1/16 BT" "1/45 NBT" 12" Hemlock \$68W 16.25" 8" Maple S68E 20.6" "1/45 NBT" "SW1/16 BT" 4" Balsam SS4N 22.65" 12" Maple S45W 15.6 "SM1/16 BT" "1/45 NBT" 8" Soruce S18E 12.1" 6" Balsan NOSH 7.5' 10" Hemlock S40E 11.3' "SW1/16 8T" 8" Maple M50E 20.3" "1/45 HBT" Bearings are magnetic. Placed a 3" squared and scribed cedar post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic.
