

(I5) Found the 1972 monument, in good condition, at record bearing and distance from the 1972 mitnesses. Set measuring nails in and marked new top blazes on the the 1972 witnesses and also marked two new witnesses as described below. Left the monument in place. (14) Found the 1972 monument as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the remaining R. Pine S13W accessory. The other mitness was not recovered. The corner monument is buried on the east side of the road, in the shoulder. Marked a new top blaze and set a measuring nail in the remaining 1972 tree and marked three new witnesses as described below. Corner rewitnessed by T.Stark and D.Lampela, Newberry.
