A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: (13-Sec. 10) Southeast 1/16 corner, Section 10. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record. (5-Sec. 10) Worth 1/16 corner, Section 10. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(13-Sec. 10) Found no monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/16 corners. The 1/16 corners to the East, South and West are monumented. That to the north is not currently monumented. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"IDx36" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner lies on the edge of a hill. Corner placed by T.Stark and D.Lampela, Newberry. (5-Sec. 10) Found no monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner midway and on a straight line between 1/4 corner 1320.10' north and Center of Section 1320.10' south. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1" IDx36" iron pipe capped with a 4"

dia, cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed by T.Stark and D.Lampela, Newberry.
