

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K5) Corner common to Sections 11-12-13-14. Corner reestablished in 1980 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS: "Placed corner in center of East-Mest road and in line with a fence to South. Found remains of an old fence to North. Buried 36" "T"-iron. 6" H. Maple M50M 43.6', 12" H. Haple NIOE 27.7', 8" H. Maple N32E 37.3"".

(J3) Quarter corner common to Sections 2-11. Corner reestablished in 1984 by Gerald L. Miggins, RLS: "Corner set M.P.O.L. between Section Corners 1/2 mile East and Nest. Set D.H.R. monument. 7" H. Maple N23E 10.5', 12" H. Maple N70E 14.0', 10" Y. Birch S34E 14.5', 14" Seech, NSSW 6.5'".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(K5) Recovered the 1980 monument, as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1980 witness trees, all in good condition. Laft the monument in place, set measuring nails in the record accessories, and marked one new tree as described below. Corner recovered and rewitnessed by T.Stark and M.Feldpausch, Newberry District Office.

(J3) Recovered the 1984 monument as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1984 accessories. I determined that the 1984 monument was placed at an erroneous and unintended location approximately 25' SSE of the proper position. I rejected the existing monument, removed it, and reinstalled it midway and on a line of mean true bearing between Sections corners 2653.91' East and West. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark and M.Feldpausch, Newberry District Office.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner (K5) found t iron. Set measuring (J3) 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap. Blazed,
