A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(Lt) Quarter corner common to Section 1 T44M-R11W and Section 36 T45M-R11W. Corner established in 1841 by John Burt: "West on south side of section 36 (T45M R11M)...40.00 set gr. section post, Sugar 16 M55E 28, Birch 16 M26M 15...80.00 set post corner of sections 35 4 36". This corner was reestablished in 1979 by Billy D. Buckler, RtS, by the method of single proportionate measurement, but the position was not monumented. Buckler measured 5326.4° between X1 and M1. He used the SPM position to control his 1979 subdivision of Section 1.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(LI) Original post and accessories not recovered. Found no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Reestablished the corner by single proportionate measurement to the original record - midway and on a line of mean true bearing between reestablished section corners 2661.66' east and west. The observed mean true bearing of this line was \$89 deg. 48' 55"E. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1" IO x 36" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark and M.Feldpausch, Newberry District Office.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

(L1) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring mails in the following: "1/45 NBT" 14" Ironwood #69E 12.4" 20° Maple N22E 18.2° "1/4S NBT" "1/45 NBT" 10" Maple N77W 26.3" 8" Maple \$48W 18.4" "1/4S NBT" Placed a squared cedar post adjacent. Searings are magnetic.
