

I. Stephan J. Szyszkoski , in a field survey on \_\_\_\_\_\_, 19 \_\_\_\_ do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(9-Sec. 6) East 1/16 corner of Section 6. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(9-Sec. 6) found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner midway and on a straight line between Quarter corner 1281.34' East and Center of Section 1281.34' West. At the position for the corner, which is located on top of the cut stump of a 12" cedar, I placed an 8" long iron spike driven through a yellow plastic cap stamped "MICH DMR PS 33986". I placed a 1° I.O. x 36° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDMR tablet, appropriately stamped, adjacent to the stump. The pipe is bent over so that the tablet is above the spike. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark and M.Feldpausch, Newberry District Office.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

(9) Set 8" iron spike with yellow

plastic cap in 12" cedar stump.

Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails

in the following:

6" Cedar N40E 18.2"

10° Cedar S38E 16.0' "E1/16 87"

12" Cedar NOSE 7.65" "E1/16 BT"

5" Cedar S60M 9.05" "E1/16 BT"

Placed a 4" squared and scribed cedar

post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic.
