A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Two irons were found at this location. One iron (uncapped) matches the witnesses recorded in L2763 P565 and L2925 P469, both from Dunn Construction. The other iron was not capped, but cap #30085 was found nearby and the witnesses from L6728 P625 fit this iron. The irons are 1.6' apart in a north-south direction. Mr. King was contacted to discuss the location of the corner. He supplied field notes and recalled that the iron was set next to an old pinch pipe. Mr. King indicated that pinch pipes have not been used in this area for many years. Therefore, this found pipe is probably quite old. No reference is made about the other iron in Mr. King's notes, nor does Mr. King recall any other irons at this location. Dunn Construction supplied copies of their field notes, which do not show a pinch pipe at this corner. The "James" iron will be accepted as the best location of the corner, because his notes imply that no other irons or pinch pipes were at this location at the time of his survey.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a 3/4" by 24" rebar with a 2" diameter aluminum cap stamped "Macomb County Monument MI ACT A5 34970" 0.56' W of the "James" iron on the township line.

5°	16.02'	Set PK and Macomb County Remonumentation tag in the E face of a utility pole.
130°	98.55'	Set PK and Macomb County Remonumentation tag in the SW face of a utility pole.
275°	37.30'	Set PK and Macomb County Remonumentation tag in the S face of a 12" Spruce.
200°	73.48'	Set PK and Macomb County Remonumentation tag in the E face of a twin 24" Box Elder.
180°	117.03'	Set a 3/4" by 24" rebar with a 2" diameter aluminum (M4, T4N, R13E)

The selected location is accepted by me and is generally accepted by Professional Surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

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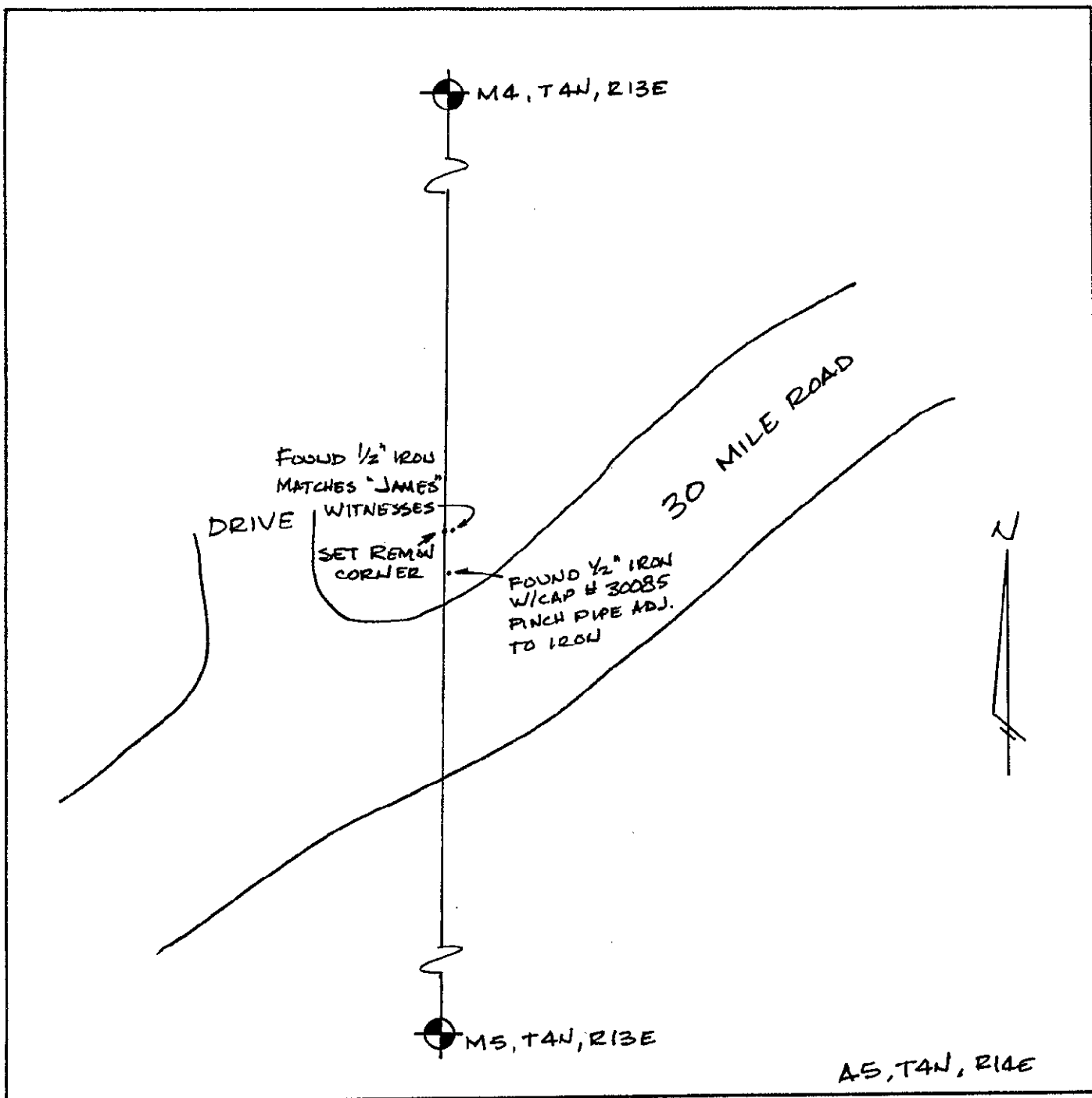
