Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: SE Cor Sec 36 (24-15) & SW Cor Sec 31 (24-14) & NE Cor Sec 1 (23-15) & NW Cor Sec 6 (23-14) On June 29, 2000, I Anthony M. Sławinski, along with a field crew from Abonmarche, found a 3" x 3' narrow gauge railroad rail in a monument box. Beside of the rail was a 2' long Pine post (somewhat decayed). We found no other evidence to dispute this location for the corner.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: SE Cor Sec 36 (24-15) & SW Cor Sec 31 (24-14) & NE Cor Sec 1 (23-15) & NW Cor Sec 6 (23-14) On June 29, 2000, I installed a Manistee County Monument, within a monument box, in the exact location of the above mentioned railroad rail as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner, and witnessed by:
