B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:	
L-01 North Quarter Corner of Section 1, T24N, R13W and South Quarter Corner of Section 36, T25N, R13W.  Found capped rebar described by Max Harris. Recovered references 4, 5, 6 and identified trees as Jack Pines (see part C). References 1, 2 and 3 are gone. Recovered a capped 1/2" rebar by R. Mitchell & Associates, showing PLS #s 28147 and 30079 (see Part C, reference 9). Found no conflicting evidence as to the location of this corner. It is also my opinion this corner is being used as common corner since only one corner monument was found at the site.  Note: This corner in my opinion may be considered as a common 1/4 corner between Sections 1, T24N, R13W and Section 36, T25N, R13W because the closing corner of sections 1 and 2 is common with the standard corner of sections 35 and 36 and to the East the township corner is common. GLO measurement places the South 1/4 of Section 36 at the mid-point and on line between the NW and NE corners of section 1. For additional information see the Manual of Surveying Instructions For 1973, Section 3-87 which in my opinion only authorizes the setting of a second quarter corner along township and range lines where double section corners were established in the GLO survey.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the postion of the corner:  LOI North Quarter Corner of Section 1, T24N, R13W.  The position not established by original government surveyors (majority opinion of the peer group). Accepted the 1/2" rebar as the best available evidence of the position of the corner and on May 17th, 1999 and set a Standard Manistee County monument stamped to identify the corner in a monument box.
