

Corner Section 31 (24-14) & Northeast Corner of Section 6 (23-14) On June 9, 2000, I, Anthony M. Slawinski along with a field crew from Abonmarche found a 1 ½ " iron pipe ±16' North of the center line of 13 mile road. The distance between this corner and the South ¼ corner of Section 32 was checked against the Wilcox distance and it checked to be within 0.24'.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.
