I, Anthony M. Slawinski, in a field survey on June 2, 20 00 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Southeast Section Corner Section 24 (24-14) & Southwest Section Corner Section 19 (24-13) Set by John Brink in 1837.

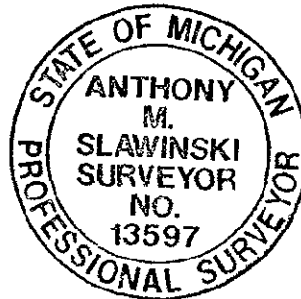
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Southeast Section Corner Section 24 (24-14) & Southwest Section Corner Section 19 (24-13) On June 2, 2000, I Anthony M. Slawinski, along with a field crew from Abonmarche found a DNR disc and Pipe by a Carsonite Post. We found no other evidence to dispute this location for the corner.

Condition of witnesses: #1 gone, #2 gone, #3 good, #4 good & #5 good

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Southeast Section Corner Section 24 (24-14) & Southwest Section Corner Section 19 (24-13) On June 2, 2000, I accepted the DNR disc and Pipe as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner, and witnessed by:

- 3. S 54° E 75.66' 34" Triple Cherry (set 60d on SW side of tree)
4. S 52° W 94.50' 30" Twin Cherry (set 60d on N side of tree)
5. N 82° E 94.52' 33" Twin Cherry (set 60d on S side of tree)
6. N 55° W 44.89' 12" Cherry (set 60d on W side of tree)

Corner is +/- 285' West of Thompsonville Rd.
Carsonite Post is 1' North
