I, Anthony M. Slawinski , in a field survey on June 29 , 20 00 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Southeast Section Corner Section 35 (24-15)

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Southeast Section Corner Section 35 (24-15)

On June 29, 2000, I Anthony M. Slawinski, along with a field crew from Abonmarche, found a 1/2" x 18" iron rod, in a monument box, over a ½" iron pipe. We found no other evidence to dispute this location for the corner.

Condition of witnesses: #1 gone, #2 gone, #3 gone, #4 gone, #5 gone, #6 gone & #7 good

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Southeast Section Corner Section 35 (24-15)

On June 29, 2000, I installed a Manistee County Monument, within a monument box, in the exact location as the above mentioned ½" rod and ½" pipe as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner, and witnessed by:

8. N 63° E 80.84' 30" Twin Ash (fd 60d spike on SE side of tree)

9. South 24.49' Power Pole (fd 60d spike on E side of pole)

10. N 41° W 70.12' 12" Ash (fd 40d spike on E side of tree)

11. North 41.50' ½" iron rod w/cap #10681 (Bruning)

The corner is in the centerline of 13 Mile Road, and the closing corner for T23N, R15W is East, 82.50'. Without #7


