B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:  
 I found the 5" square by 60" long concrete monument w/ brass cap by Griffin destroyed. The following witnesses present in 1972 are now gone: Griffin's P.Post, Fence cor. Post, and Landon's W.Pine 30". The Oak 40" by Dunlap is really a cottonwood. Liber 1 Page 189 by Griffin documents the history of this corner. This monument is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

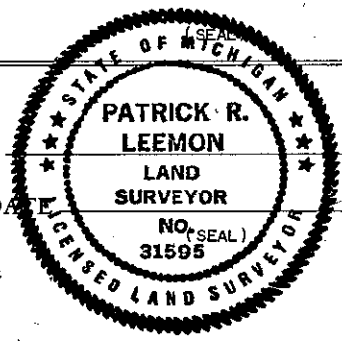
**Section corner common to section 31 of T17N R15W, section 36 of T17N R16W, section 6 of T16N R15W and section 1 of T16N R16W.**  
 Monu. Placed the old brass cap in bottom of hole and set a 2"x30" Iron Pipe w/brass cap 4" beneath the surface.
