A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Corner Common to Sections 25 and 26, T.17N., R.15W.,

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Corner Common to Sections 25 and 26, T.17N., R.15W.,

Found a 12' long bolt spike in a monument box, 0.5' West of the center-line of Masten Road. Witnesses (1), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9) and (10) have been destroyed. Witnesses (2) and (4) are in, but distances vary depending on date of survey. I found no other evidence to dispute the location of this corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Corner Common to Sections 25 and 26, T.17N., R.15W.,

I replaced the 12" long bolt spike in the exact location with a 5/8" X 18" re-rod with the standard 2 1/2" aluminum disk stamped "Mason County Monument, 19846" inside the Monument Box. This corner accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the original corner.
