

Stop sign \$50°W 23.3 Et. 37.0 ft. N80°E Stop sign

In 1973, J. Borsfay following road construction reset corner from corner references. Set 1" dia. X 25" pipe with the following corner references:

58.3 ft. 99.14 ft. 100.60 ft. Power pole SE 1011 Maple Willow NE 8"

In 1988, Gordon Bonney used corner to established the Center Quarter to Section 31. No references (see Liber 372, page 769 in the Mason Co. Register of Deed's Office).
