In 1886, Mason-Oceana railroad map shows the distance to the corner from the railroad. Information filed in the Mason County Register of Deed's Office.

In 1888, W.E. Metcalf (Deputy Co. Surveyor) surveyed Section 4 and found corner (see Co. Surveyor Record Book 1, page in the Mason Co. Register of Deed's Office).

In 1957, the Mason Co. Road Commission recorded iron for monument. The following corner references: Fence corner N40°W 44.2 ft. Fence corner NE 42.7 ft. T P S45°E 47.5 ft.
